During the 2016/2017 reporting period, Conservatorio Superior de Música del Principado de Asturias CONSMUPA undertook a number of activities that underscore its commitment to UNAI and its principles. The following examples stand out as particularly noteworthy:

#### **Public Concert of the students of the institution in collaboration with the University of Oviedo (Asturias) “Los Conciertos del Paraninfo”**

CONSMUPA is honored to participate to the Program UNAI (United Nations Academic Impact), which commits the Institution to the building of a more united and collaborative society. The aim of the project is to give opportunity for all people - regardless of gender, race, religion or ethnicity- to enter an higher level of education.

In order to do that, the Conservatory of Oviedo organizes every year *Los conciertos del Paraninfo*, a number of open music concerts in collaboration with the students of the University of Oviedo, in order to encourage people to acquire the skills and knowledge necessary for the pursuit of higher education in music, giving also the opportunity to perform in front of a public during open live shows settled in the city.



It is a week of public concerts, designed for people who do not have this knowledge and do not have access to this type of free entertainment.
