During the 2013-14 period, EDU has upheld its strong commitment to the promotion of core UNAI principles. Of particular note are the following activities:

In association with the Balkan Chamber of Commerce (BCC), EDU worked to promote sustainability through entrepreneurship—particularly among vulnerable populations, such as women, youth and the rural poor.

Through an agreement with the Diplomatic Corps Institute (DCI), EDU secured three, fully paid scholarships in order to provide financial support to promising students from poor, rural communities.



Sponsored summer workshops in 6 cities promoted intercultural dialogue and understanding, volunteer work in education and cooperation amongst communities to ensure an expansion of access to educational and development-related opportunities for vulnerable groups.

The Secretary-General of EDU, Irving Le-Vance, visited over a dozen developing countries, speaking with leading governmental figures, diplomats, and ministers about quality of education and plans to further expand access to education for women, youth, and the rural poor.
