## Grenoble Ecole de Management

### France

During the 2013-14 reporting period, Grenoble Ecole de Management (GEM) engaged in a number of activities that underscore its on-going commitment to UNAI and its principles. The following examples stand out as particularly notable:



GEM created a new position in 2014: the Chair of Mindfulness, Well-being and Economic Peace Education. The mission of this individual is to contribute to the development of knowledge, practices and training focused on the management of occupational stress, on well-being, on the personal development of managers, on an evolution in management methods and on the understanding of a new industrial model centered on the highest human values and on economic peace in order to promote sustainable and shared value creation.

To kick off its innovative citizenship “skills-share” policy for all faculty and staff at the school, GEM hosted a Pro-Bono Marathon. The “skills-share” policy involves the school offering its faculty and staff 5 days per year to share their skills to benefit non-profit organizations.
