During the 2013-14 period, International University “MITSO” has upheld its strong commitment to the promotion of core UNAI principles. Of particular note are the following projects:

In May of 2013, VIII International Law Competition “Youth for Peace”—an annual contest for students of international law—was held at International University “MITSO”. The conference’s participants were expected to demonstrate excellent knowledge of international public law, international humanitarian law and human rights law, as well as the ability to adapt and reorient during armed conflict simulation exercises. The event also provided excellent opportunities for its participants to engage in experience sharing, team building and cross-cultural communication, while promoting inter-cultural dialogue between participants from different countries through its celebration of cultural diversity.



International Law Competition “Youth for Peace”

Days of International Law at International University “MITSO” featured a series of lectures delivered by prominent scholars and well-known experts in international law. In 2013, speakers included representatives from New Zealand (Prof. Alberto Costi), Germany (Prof. Hans-Joachim Heintze), Australia (Prof. Steven Freeland) and Belarus (Adrey L. Kozik). The lectures were open to the public and were attended by conference participants, students and teachers of International University “MITSO”, representatives of other Belarusian universities, government agencies and organizations. The lectures covered the topics of state responsibility and individual criminal liability as a means of encouraging respect for international humanitarian law (IHL), Informational Technology and IHL, space, and the relationship between IHL and human rights law.
