



# UNAI MEMBER ACTIVITY REPORTS 2013-2014

## Long Island University

### USA

During the 2013-14 reporting period, Long Island University (LIU) has engaged in a number of activities that underscore its on-going commitment to UNAI and its principles. The following examples stand out as particularly notable:

In September of 2013, LIU's "CHATS" program brought together local and foreign students with the goal of expanding these students' knowledge of languages, cultures, art, and religions from all parts of the world.

Also in the fall of 2013, LIU hosted a conference entitled "Muslim Journeys", which included exhibits, programs, book discussions, films and lectures focused on the cultural heritage of Islamic civilization. Soon thereafter, the University organized and conducted a workshop on "Regional Implications of the Arab Spring and the United Nations' response".

Other events at the University in 2013-14 included the launching of a foreign ambassador speaker series, an international student cultural show, Islamic Awareness Week, and a low-cost housing building/project eradication volunteer project trip to Tijuana, Mexico.
