



UNAI MEMBER ACTIVITY REPORTS 2013-2014

Rikkyo University

Japan

During the 2013-14 reporting period, Rikkyo University has engaged in a number of activities that underscore its on-going commitment to UNAI and its principles. The following examples stand out as particularly notable:

Rikkyo University is a contributing institution to the Human Resource Development Program for International Cooperation. The aim of this program—which is run by a consortium of three Japanese universities—is to aid the development of individuals possessing knowledge and the ability to address complex issues faced by the global community. With the assistance of six partner institutions, the Program for International Cooperation offers lectures and fieldwork courses at the three participating universities. In 2013-14, these courses included Introduction to Global Issues, Liberal Arts for Global Common, International Cooperation Literacy, and Active Research.

The University began sending its students abroad as United Nations Youth Volunteers between September 2013 and March 2014, when three Rikkyo students were sent to East Timor, Vietnam, and Cambodia, respectively.
