



UNAI MEMBER ACTIVITY REPORTS 2013-2014

SUNY Delhi

During the 2013-14 reporting period, SUNY Delhi has engaged in a number of activities that underscore its on-going commitment to UNAI and its principles. The following examples stand out as particularly notable:

The University planted 13 Centennial trees to commemorate its 100th anniversary, raise money for student scholarships, stabilize soil, clean air, produce shade, and generate oxygen.

SUNY Delhi established the Service Learning Committee to encourage community involvement through academics.

The current reporting period saw a widespread shift to paperless technology: in files for tenure, promotion, enrolment services and financial aid, textbooks, and medical records in health services.



The University also increased purchasing from female and minority-owned businesses to 20%.

Finally, SUNY Delhi published a peer-reviewed article about integrating sustainability across its campus.
