During the 2013-14 reporting period, Tohoku University engaged in a number of activities that underscore its on-going commitment to UNAI and its principles. The following example stands out as particularly notable:

The current reporting period saw Tohoku University organize and host a special lecture by the Rector of the UN University, entitled *The UN Security Council: Boom or Bust?* The event provided attendees with a better understanding of the role of the UN Security Council in historical perspective. Focusing on the time period immediately after the Cold War, the lecture covered new features of decision-making and organizational developments affecting the UN Security Council. 122 people attended the event.
