Universitas 21

UK/USA

During the 2013-14 reporting period, Universitas 21 engaged in a number of activities that underscore its on-going commitment to UNAI and its principles. The following examples stand out as particularly notable:

Universitas 21 has developed a series of case studies to raise awareness of the UN's Millennium Development Goals (UNMDG) among health sciences students. Since 2012, 628 students have taken part in one or more of these case studies, which are run on a regular basis. In 2013, a competition was initiated that challenged students to generate posters designed to raise awareness of the UNMDG.



Additionally, Universitas 21 sponsored a month-long intensive activity for students in Guatemala, in association with the Social Entrepreneur Corps and organized through the University of Connecticut. The activity was structured so as to enable students from a variety of disciplinary backgrounds to gain hands-on experience exploring micro-business as a catalyst for development. A separate, interdisciplinary programme on the subject of human rights was also organized through Universitas 21 for students at the University of Connecticut.

Finally, Universitas 21 is in the process of developing a Health Sciences Global Partnership to increase opportunities for collaborative, inter-professional, case-based and service learning activities aimed at promoting the UNMDG.
