### Australia

During the 2013-14 reporting period, Universities Australia (UA) engaged in a number of activities that underscore its on-going commitment to UNAI and its principles. The following examples stand out as particularly notable:

During the current reporting period, UA has been working closely with the Bahá'í Community in Canberra to reach out to all member institutions regarding the plight of the Bahá'í people and the on-going Education Under Fire campaign.



UA has also managed a campaign to increase aspiration for and awareness of international study experiences, in order to develop truly global citizens of the future.

UA has just agreed to engage in a collaborative effort with the Scholars at Risk (SAR) global network to establish an Australian SAR chapter.

Additionally, UA organized an Australia-Indonesia Knowledge Exchange program in 2014.

Finally, UA is negotiating agreements with numerous Latin American countries to allow students with scholarships to study in Australian institutions.
