During the 2013-14 reporting period, the University of Bridgeport (UB) engaged in a number of activities that underscore its on-going commitment to UNAI and its principles. The following examples stand out as particularly notable:

The University of Bridgeport student body attended United Nations briefings at UN headquarters on March 22nd and November 1st, 2013.

On April 10th, 2013, the University invited Dr. Pingfang Hong, Chief of Global Economic Monitoring at the Department of Economic and Social Affairs (ECOSOC), to speak on “The Eurozone Crisis and its Implications for the European Union”.

Additionally, the University of Bridgeport participated in the UN DPI NGO Higher Education meeting on the 30th of January, 2014, and was represented by Dr. Dave Benjamin.

University of Bridgeport Dean Thomas J. Ward served as Poster Session Chair at the 2014 CTAUN Conference.

A visit by Tijiana Bokic, UB Alum and member of the United Nations General Assembly Fellowship on Disarmament program engaged students directly on the question of disarmament and associated challenges.



Finally, the University continues to offer graduate-level courses in International Conflict and Negotiation, using valuable course material developed by the US Institute for Peace. Courses on cross-cultural communication, the socio-political implications of the world’s religions, and globalization are also offered.
