



UNAI MEMBER ACTIVITY REPORTS 2013-2014

University of Sindh

Pakistan

During the 2013-14 reporting period, the University of Sindh engaged in a number of activities that underscore its on-going commitment to UNAI and its principles. The following examples stand out as particularly notable:

The University established 8 additional campuses in various rural districts of Sindh Province, in Pakistan, to provide impoverished youth with greater opportunity for pursuing higher education.

Foreign scholarships worth 10 million Rs. each were awarded to around 100 members of the University's faculty and student body to study abroad in 2013-14.



The University also introduced a compulsory course on Universal Human Values in Higher Education in an effort to combat “the menace of extremism”.

At its Matiari District campus, the University established the world's first “Campus on Sufism and Peace” in 2014.

Finally, in collaboration with Germany's Hanns Seidel Foundation, the University organized an international conference entitled “Extremism and Terrorism in Pakistan: Challenges and Sustainable Solutions”. The event took place in April of 2013.
