



UNAI MEMBER ACTIVITY REPORTS 2013-2014

During the 2013-14 reporting period, William V.S. Tubman University (TU) engaged in a number of activities that underscore its on-going commitment to UNAI and its principles. In fact, because of the number of international activities that are regularly held on campus, the phrase “International Education is Everyday at TU” was adopted. The following examples stand out as particularly notable:

On International Women’s Day, a meeting was held that set in motion the process that eventually resulted in the establishment of TU’s Gender and Development Center.

An on-campus event featured a livestreamed feed of the 50th Anniversary celebration of the “March on Washington”.

Upon their return to campus, TU students that participated in study abroad programs presented on their experiences in a series of “Around the World” presentations.

One TU student represented the University at the Harvard National Model UN Conference, in 2014.

Finally, during a panel presentation, TU’s International Education Dean announced an initiative to train pre-college youth on conflict resolution tactics. This is a joint project with the National Bar Association (NBA) and the Angie Brooks International Centre (ABIC).
